According to Dobson DaVanzo Study: Therapy Outcomes in Post-Acute Care Settings (TOPS), therapy is beneficial to most Medicare recipients.

PT/OT benefits most patients

Significant rehabilitative values were shown across 1.4 million Medicare cases.

PT/OT provides positive value

Show useful for rehab and preventing the decline of core function and daily activities in post-acute care.

Therapy increases function

Increased therapy intensity positively correlated with functional increases in post-acute care.



Readmissions decrease with therapy

30-day hospital readmission rates following postacute care episode decreased after therapy

Payers should encourage appropriate therapy use
