CMS GUIDANCE FOR COVID

9 Core Principles

1 SCREENING ALL

Screen everyone entering with temperature checks and sign/symptom checks. Deny entry as needed.



2 PROPER HAND HYGIENE

Wash hands regularly and use alcohol-based hand rub.




3 ALL FACES COVERED

Mandate face coverings or mask that include both nose and mouth.



6-FT SOCIAL DISTANCE

Maintain at least 6-feet distance between all persons.



INSTRUCTIONAL SIGNAGE

Educate visitors on signs/symptoms, infection control, and facility requirements (i.e., masks, hand hygiene).



SURFACE DISINFECTION

Clean and disinfect high frequency touched surfaces often and designated visitation areas after every visit.



STAFF USE OF PPE

Appropriate staff use of PPE.



8 RESIDENT COHORTING

Create separate areas dedicated to COVID-19 care.



9 TESTING ALL

Test all residents and staff for COVID-19 per the guidance in CMS August 26, 2020 memo (see <u>QSO-20-38-NH</u>). Testing visitors is also encouraged with regular visitors prioritized.



ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE

Schedule and limit visitors, as well as movement within facility.

Outdoor visitation preferred; inside is ok for compassionate care reasons

Compassionate care does not just refer to end-of-life and may include residents:

- Recently-admitted/struggling with transition
- Grieving recent friend/family death
- Needing encouragement to eat/drink
- Experiencing emotional distress, seldom speaking or frequently crying
